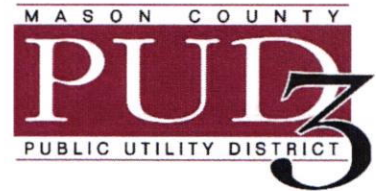

Air Source Heat Pump Customer Checklist

Single-family homes may be eligible for a PUD 3 incentive when converting or upgrading to an energy efficient heat pump. Incentives vary depending on a number of factors, so be sure to contact your PUD 3 representative for accurate information.

Choose a licensed HVAC contractor to install your new air source heat pump. In order to qualify for an incentive, your new air source heat pump must have a Heating Seasonal Performance Factor (HSPF) rating of 9.0 or higher and a Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) rating of 14 or higher and must be AHRI tested and certified. You must also supply either a contractor/equipment invoice which lists the model number of the installed unit. The heat pump must be installed according to the Air Source Heat Pump Installation Specifications found at www.bpa.gov/ResHVAC. PUD 3 recommends getting at least three quotes.

Choose a Performance Tested Comfort Systems (PTCS) certified technician to perform PTCS heat pump commissioning on your newly installed system. Successful heat pump commissioning is required for PUD 3 incentives to be paid. Your home may also need to have its duct work tested and sealed in order to qualify.

Please ensure that the installing contractor and/or electrician secure a Washington State Labor & Industries (L&I) electrical permit AND a Mason County or City of Shelton mechanical permit BEFORE installation. Copies of the final and approved permits will be required before PUD 3 incentives can be paid. Manufactured homes only require L&I permits.
